BMF KENYA WASTE MANAGEMENT OUTREACH
PROGRAM REQUEST

BMF Kenya is request the men of BMF United Kingdom, and friends, to assist us to purchase collection gear, for garbage collectors, which consists of BMF branded reflector jackets, gloves, masks and identification badges. We have acquired a unique opportunity to collaborate with National Environmental Management Authority (NEMA) to network garbage collectors around the country. These men will become members of BMF in wards around the country. We shall mobilise groups of around 100 members in most of the 1,450 wards in the country. Each of them will become Chapter members in their respective wards.

Our mandate as BMF is to mobilise the collectors and give them the collection gear (branded reflector jackets, gloves, masks and a special identification badge).

Recycling companies, through NEMA, will give a small stipend to these collectors for collecting plastic, paper, organic and electronic waste. This stipend will contribute greatly to their personal livelihood and enable them to attend Chapter and outreach meetings.

We shall hold weekly Chapter outreaches among these collectors. We are targeting street families and jobless men in the wards.

Through our contribution in this project, we stand a better chance to reach out to Government institutions, companies and the community at large.

A package for one person is priced at Kenya shillings 1,000 or 8 pounds. We can buy as many as we can on a monthly basis, with your support. We shall provide photos of every group formed and reports of outreaches among the collectors. The project will start as soon as we are able to provide the packages.

REPORT ON BMF UGANDA WORK FOR SEPTEMBER 2022


On 28th September, Tamale Moses and I set off from Kampala very early in the morning to go to Bullisa Prison. We were delayed on the way because of the heavy rain in the morning which broke the bridge of the road which we had to use and cross in the afternoon. We had to turn and use an alternative route which added about 60 miles to our journey. We arrived there at 4:00pm when the inmates were inside the cells. The OC welcomed us and assembled all of them in the main hall, Tamale Moses gave a brief explanation about BMF, and he narrated the way we travelled, and then he gave his testimony in short. I gave my full story and then 467 men received salvation out of 512 men enrolled in that unit. We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to that prison at the end.

On 29th September, Tamale Moses and I went to Bisso Prison. We arrived at 9:00 am when the inmates had finished morning assembly and breakfast as well. The deputy O.C welcomed us and took us in his office to sign in the visitor's book. He asked the Officer on duty to take back all the inmates from the assembly to listen to the good news from us. 286 men assembled. Moses gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 253 men received salvation, of which two were prison wardens. We had enough time to minister to those men who received salvation after and then one of them testified about the dream he had the previous night when he was with the angels taking him to heaven. He realised that God was telling him to receive salvation through us. We donated five boxes of washing soap and four Bibles to the prison at the end.

On 30th September, Tamale Moses and I went to Butyala Prison. We arrived at 8:00 am when the inmates were still in the morning assembly. We waited until the O.C and other prison wardens finished their communication to the inmates, and then we started delivering the good news to them. Moses gave a brief explanation about BMF followed by his short testimony, and then I gave my full story. 349 men received salvation out of 376 men enrolled in that unit. We prayed for all of them at the end. Moses ministered to them for more than 15 minutes, and then we gave out five boxes of washing soap and Four bibles to that prison at the end.
